Small groups will present Dual Federalism I and II; Cooperative Federalism; Creative Federalism; and Devolution. Presentations will cover the changes in the State-Federal power arrangement through Court Cases, Laws, Executive actions, Grants and Mandates.

Also included should be any major court cases that may have affected Federalism as well as any societal change, legislation, executive action or amendments that do the same. They must make sure they explain their era and how it changes Federalism
